

#### **ASSEMBLE TV BASE**

- 1.Lay TV on a flat & clean surface, with TV screen face down
- 2. Attach neck to the TV with supplied screws
- 3. Attach base to the neck with supplied screws

#### **FIRST TIME SETUP**

- 1.Connect antenna cable to TV "ANT" Port
- 2.Connect power cord to TV and wall socket
- 3.Insert batteries to remote and press **b** to turn on TV.

#### **SETUP WIZARD**

- 1.TV will enter SETUP WIZARD (or press MENU on remote, select SETUP > SETUP WIZARD)
- 2.Follow the on-screen steps to setup language, time and channel scan






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### **Remote Controller**



#	Button	Description
1	ப் (power)	Press to turn your TV on or off (standby mode).
2	Numbers	Press to enter channel numbers and the parental control password.
3	•	Press to enter a digital sub-channel number.
4	ENTER	Press to confirm selections or changes.
(5)	MENU	Press to open the on-screen menu.

#	Button	Description
6	EXIT	Press to close the on-screen menu.
7	ASPECT	Press to change how the picture looks on the screen (aspect ratio).
8	VOL+/-	Press to increase or decrease the volume.
9	SLEEP	Press to set the sleep timer.
1	FAVORITE	Press to open the Favorite
11)	USB Operation	Press to start the photo playback. Press to pause the photo playback. Press to top the photo playback. Press to play backward faster. Press to play forward faster. Press to play forward faster. Press to view the previous photo.
12)	INPUT	Press to open the <i>INPUT SOURCE</i> list, press ◀ or ▶ o the remote control to select the video input source, then press <b>ENTER</b>
13	(return)	In TV mode, press to return to the previous channel.
14)	A <b>V 4</b> Þ	Press to navigate in on-screen menus and to adjust settings.
13		Press to open the ROKU menu. (Not available)
16)	INFO*	Press to display TV status information, such as the channel number, channel name (if available), or signal
17	CCD	Press to turn closed captioning on or off. You can sele CC Off, CC On, or CC On When Mute
18)	MUTE	Press to mute the sound. Press again to restore the sound.
19	CH  /CH	Press to change TV channels.
20	MTS/SAP	Press to select the audio mode for an analog program You can select:  • Mono—Select this option if there is noise of static on weak stereo broadcasts.  • Stereo—Select this option for programs broadcast in stereo.  • SAP—Select this option to listen to a secondary audio program, if available.
21	PICTURE	Press to select the picture mode.
22	AUDIO	Press to select the sound mode.
